Day 1 | 25 October

Arrival via King Hussein Bridge – Little Petra – Petra

Upon arrival at King Hussein Bridge, you will be welcomed and begin your journey through Jordan's beautiful landscapes towards Petra.

Visit the enchanting Little Petra (Siq al-Barid), a hidden Nabataean settlement

carved into sandstone cliffs. Once an important trading stop along ancient caravan routes, Little Petra offers a fascinating introduction to the history and culture of the Nabataeans.

Continue to Petra and check in to your hotel. The remainder of the day is at leisure to relax and prepare for tomorrow's exploration of Jordan's most

celebrated archaeological site.

Day 2 | 26 October

Discover Petra – The Rose-Red City – Wadi Rum

Walk through the dramatic Siq before arriving at the breathtaking Treasury. Continue exploring Petra's remarkable monuments, including the Street of Facades, the Royal Tombs, the Great Temple, and the Colonnaded Street.

Adventurous travelers may wish to climb to the spectacular Monastery for panoramic views of the surrounding mountains.

In the late afternoon, travel south to the legendary desert of Wadi Rum, often referred to as the Valley of the Moon.

Upon arrival, settle into your desert camp and enjoy a traditional Jordanian dinner beneath a sky filled with stars.

Later in the afternoon, continue to the historic city of Madaba, renowned for its Byzantine mosaics and warm hospitality.
